IASB Exposure Draft – Proposed amendments to IAS 7 (Statement of Cash Flows)

Introduction

We are the Quoted Companies Alliance, the independent membership organisation that champions the interests of small to mid-size quoted companies. Their individual market capitalisations tend to be below £500m.

The Quoted Companies Alliance is a founder member of European**Issuers**, which represents over 9,000 quoted companies in fourteen European countries.

The Quoted Companies Alliance Financial Reporting Expert Group has examined your proposals and advised on this response. A list of members of the Expert Group is at Appendix A.

Response

We welcome the opportunity to respond to this consultation.

We agree with the view expressed in paragraph AV2 of the Alternative View that the appropriate time to make such amendments is at the conclusion of the Principles of Disclosure research project as a fundamental review of IAS 7 is being carried out as part of that project. There is a cost to small companies of keeping up to date with minor changes to standards and we would question whether making this change at this point in time is cost effective.

Whilst in general we believe that the amendments provide useful information to users, we are disappointed that a net debt reconciliation is not included as, in our experience, this is a reconciliation that investors have been calling for.
