 - a) On 10 December 2019, the QCA and UHY Hacker Young published the report, *AIM Good Governance Review*. The report analysed the governance disclosures of 50 AIM companies across five specific areas: the strategic report; stakeholder engagement; board dynamics; board expertise; and succession planning.
 - b) The QCA recently released the results of its Small and Mid-Cap Sentiment Index for the last quarter of 2019. The results show near-record levels of negativity across many indicators for the 8+ years that the survey has been run, with raising capital via public equity being seen as the hardest it's been since 2013.
 - c) The results of the QCA's annual small and mid-cap investor survey are being compiled and should be released later this month.
